

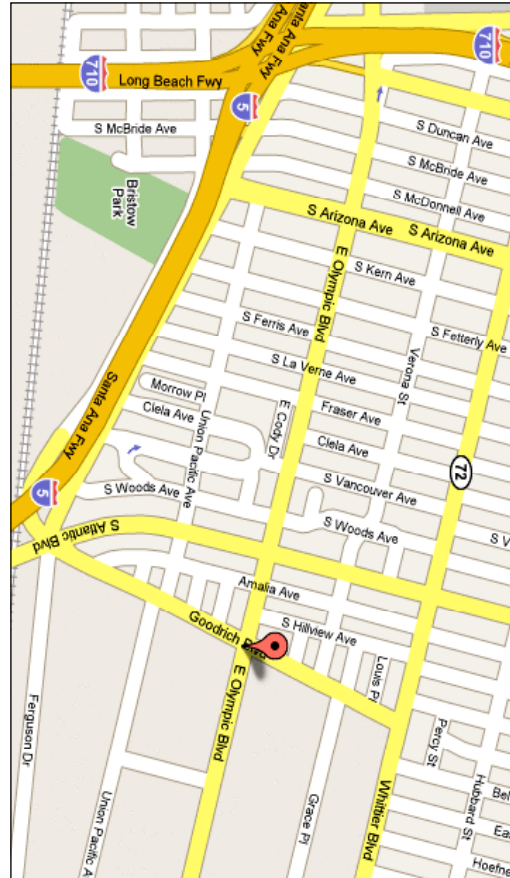
About Veterans Upward Bound
