- Be a first-generation college student
- Be pursuing a Masters degree in Business Administration or Engineering (Students pursuing other graduate degrees may also be considered at the Foundation's discretion)
- Have a minimum GPA of 2.5
- Be enrolled in a graduate program full-time for the entire 2010-2011 academic year*
- Be a permanent resident (preferred) of unincorporated East Los Angeles, Bell Gardens, Commerce, Huntington Park, City of Los Angeles, Montebello, Monterey Park, Pico Rivera, Pomona and the Inland Empire, Santa Ana, South Gate, or other communities selected by the TELACU Education Foundation for inclusion in the Program

**Priority will be given to students in their last year of graduate studies; however, first-year graduate students may be considered.*

SELECTION CRITERIA

A select pool of applicants will be invited to interview, and will be ranked according to their ability to demonstrate a combination of the following:

- Outstanding leadership potential
- Remarkable record of professional/extracurricular achievement
- Commitment to the development and economic empowerment of communities
- Need for financial support in order to successfully complete a graduate program

APPLICATION SUBMISSION

Required Documents

An application is considered "complete" only if it is accompanied by the following documents.

1. Personal Narrative

A written statement of at least one page addressing the following:

What are some of the successes you have achieved and challenges you have faced in fulfilling your mission statement, and how would this Fellowship support you in its fulfillment?

2. Letters of Recommendation

Each applicant must submit two letters of recommendation.

Letters should be on organization letterhead and address the following:

- Reference's relationship to applicant
- Length of time acquainted with applicant
- Applicant's strengths and weaknesses
- Applicant's goals
- Examples that elaborate on the applicant's commitment to the community

3. Official Transcripts (From most recent college only)

5. A copy of ONE of the following filed documents reflecting your or your parents' finances:

- Student Aid Report (SAR)
- FAFSA Form
- 2009 Tax Return
